

On Tuesday afternoon last the High Sheriff of Gloucestershire and Mrs. Lowley-Williams gave a garden party at Chavenage, Tetbury, which was attended by between three and four hundred of the nobility and gentry of Gloucestershire and North Wiltsire. The climatic conditions were very favourable, the slight rain at mid-day giving place to a glorious afternoon. The beautiful lawns and gardens attached to the famous old Elizabethan mansion were in excellent condition, and the brilliant function passed off most successfully. Mrs. Lowley-Williams, with the charm of a graceful welcome, received the numerous guests outside the south door, from whence the scene was exceedingly picturesque, the well-defined Wiltsire hills in the distance lending a charm to a view which is perhaps unsurpassed in the two counties.
